Please help ensure that we have the money we need to help our children...

Since September 2014 ALL the children in the main school (Reception to Year Two) are entitled to a school meal, free of charge, every day - there is no need to apply for this.

In the past, the only families entitled to Free School Meals were those who were in receipt of certain benefits. In addition to the children being entitled to Free School Meals, the school also received additional funding (called Pupil Premium) to help ensure all children reach their potential.

If you are in receipt of one of the benefits which would have entitled your child to Free School Meals we will still be entitled to receive the Pupil Premium of £1320 to support teaching and learning. SO, PLEASE, WE DO NEED YOU TO APPLY.
